

# Day 3 — Correction

## Choosing to Remember

Read:

### Scripture (BSB): Psalm 77:10-12

10 So I said, “I am grieved that the right hand of the Most High has changed.”  
 11 I will remember the works of the LORD; yes, I will remember Your wonders of old.  
 12 I will reflect on all You have done and ponder Your mighty deeds.

Correction occurs when we allow Scripture to redirect our focus. The psalmist chooses remembrance over despair. This choice reframes his understanding of God's silence.

### 1. God Has Not Changed

Remembering corrects the lie that God's character fluctuates with circumstances.

### 2. God's Faithfulness Has a Record

Correction reminds us that faith rests on history, not emotion.

### 3. God Uses Memory to Heal

As we remember, fear loosens its grip.
