Living from Remembered Faith

Read:

Scripture (BSB): Psalm 77:13-15

13 Your way, O God, is holy. What god is so great as our God?

14 You are the God who works wonders; You display Your strength among the peoples.

15 With power You redeemed Your people, the sons of Jacob and Joseph. Selah

When God's faithfulness is remembered, it reshapes how we live among others. Trust grows steadier. Fear loosens. Love deepens.

1. Remembering Produces Patience

Those who trust God's faithfulness are less reactive and more present.

2. Remembering Produces Compassion

A remembered God makes us gentler with others in uncertainty.

3. Remembering Produces Witness

A life anchored in God's faithfulness quietly testifies to His worth.
