#### CONNECT — Night 1

**Read:**

**Scripture (BSB): Psalm 24:1**

1 The earth is the LORD's, and the fullness thereof, the world and all who dwell therein.

**Talk:**

- What does it mean that our marriage belongs to God?
- How does this shape how we treat each other?

**Pray:**

Thank God for His ownership and care over your marriage.

#### ENCOUNTER — Night 2

**Read:**

**Scripture (BSB): Psalm 24:3-6**

3 Who may ascend the hill of the LORD? Who may stand in His holy place?

4 He who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not lift up his soul to an idol or swear deceitfully.

5 He will receive blessing from the LORD and vindication from the God of his salvation.

6 Such is the generation of those who seek Him, who seek Your face, O God of Jacob.  
Selah

**Talk:**

- How can we help each other pursue clean hearts before God?
- Where do we need grace or honesty with one another?

**Pray:**

Ask God to shape your hearts together.

## **ANCHOR — Night 3**

**Read:**

**Scripture (BSB): Psalm 104:14-15**

**14** He makes the grass grow for the livestock and provides crops for man to cultivate, bringing forth food from the earth:

**15** wine that gladdens the heart of man, oil that makes his face to shine, and bread that sustains his heart.

**Talk:**

- How have you seen God provide for your marriage?
- Where do you need to trust God more deeply right now?

**Pray:**

Thank God for His daily provision and care.

## **RESPOND — Night 4**

**Read:**

**Scripture (BSB): Psalm 104:24**

**24** How many are Your works, O LORD! In wisdom You have made them all; the earth is full of Your creatures.

**Talk:**

- How does God's wisdom encourage you when decisions feel heavy?
- How can you seek God's wisdom together?

**Pray:**

Ask God to guide your decisions as a couple.

**SEND — Night 5****Read:****Scripture (BSB): Psalm 24:7-10**

**7** Lift up your heads, O gates! Be lifted up, O ancient doors, that the King of Glory may enter!

**8** Who is this King of Glory? The LORD strong and mighty, the LORD mighty in battle.

**9** Lift up your heads, O gates! Be lifted up, O ancient doors, that the King of Glory may enter!

**10** Who is He, this King of Glory? The LORD of Hosts— He is the King of Glory. Selah

**Talk:**

- What would it look like for your home to welcome the King of glory?
- What is one way you can honor God together this week?

**Pray:**

Praise God as King and invite Him to rule your home.
